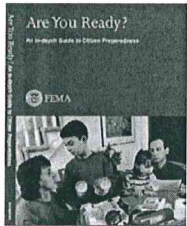

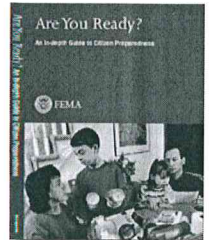

Other topics covered will be **Emergency Public Shelters, Care of People with Special Needs, Animal Care During a Disaster** and much more.

- Turning off you utilities
- Developing a Family Communication Plan
- Assist to develop a fire escape plan which can be later reviewed by visiting the East Hanover Fire Prevention Bureau;
